This illustration of course scheduling is intended to show typical sequences of courses. Most students will begin at different times or take other courses so that individual schedules will be quite different. In order to accumulate 128 total hours some semesters have a greater than 15 credit hour load. Students may want to take some of the courses in a summer session or extend their programs beyond four years. Prerequisite courses are noted in parentheses by some courses. "Co" means prerequisite or corequisite.

**Note: A grade of C- or better must be earned in all business courses and in all prerequisites.**

**Business courses can be repeated only one time without specific permission of the department chair.**
